NEW YORK SALES AND USE TAX REFORM

The General Assembly of the State of New York recently passed, and Governor Andrew Cuomo signed, sweeping tax reforms that contain good news for general aviation aircraft owners and operators; under the legislation, general aviation aircraft (defined as any aircraft used in civil aviation that is not a commercial aircraft) will be exempt from sales and use taxes in the State of New York effective as of September 1, 2015!

The New York legislation may benefit not only taxpayers who purchase aircraft on or after September 1, but potentially also taxpayers who currently own aircraft that are based in New York and operated under either a leasing structure or a Part 135 structure for tax purposes, as well as New York taxpayers who historically have based their aircraft out of state to avoid New York sales and use taxes.
